What to look for

Move one piece and a second piece behind it does the damage. Look for your own pieces standing in each other's way.

1. **22...Qxd2+ 23.Kxd2 Be8+ 24.Kc1 Bxf7** #9hmfX
The queen on d2 attacks the king on e1 and the knight on e2. Wins a rook.
2. **18.Bc2 Qc4 19.Bxh7+ Kxh7 20.Rxc4** #925lm
Wins a rook.
3. **36.Rxg4 hxg4 37.Qxd6** #83z7y
Comes out 1 pawn ahead.
4. **13.Bb5+ Kd8 14.Re8#** #6p9Ym
Mate in 2.
5. **20...Bxf2+ 21.Kxf2 Ne4+ 22.Kg1 Nxd2** #8FCZg
The bishop on f2 attacks the king on g1 and the rook on e1. Wins a rook.
6. **32...Qb7+ 33.Kc4 Na5+ 34.Rxa5 Qxg2** #94scu
Wins a rook.
7. **18...Rxe1+ 19.Bxe1 Bh2+ 20.Kxh2 Qxd5** #9HIZr
The rook on e1 attacks the king on g1 and the knight on b1. Wins a rook.
8. **37...Ne2+ 38.Kd1 Nc3#** #8wBza
The knight on e2 attacks the king on c1 and the rook on g1. Mate in 2.
9. **23.Rxg7+ Kh8 24.Rgxh7+ Kg8 25.Rg7#** #8HzjZ
Mate in 3.
10. **34...Qxg3+ 35.Kxg3 Bxd4+** #6rfNa
Comes out level on material and ahead on position.
11. **57...R8h4+ 58.Bg4 Rxc4+ 59.Kxc4 e5#** #gqdBs
Mate in 3.
12. **27...Qxd3+ 28.Kg1 Ba6 29.h3 Rxb8** #Y1HFr
The queen on d3 attacks the king on f1 and the bishop on d2. Wins a queen.

About these worksheets

This is one of three sheets for discovered attacks. The Easy and Intermediate sheets cover the same pattern at other rating bands. Thirteen other patterns are available the same way, including forks, pins, skewers, back rank mates, mate in one and smothered mate. All free, all with answer keys, no sign-up.
